

Level 2 award Health and Safety in the workplace

The Royal Society for Public Health's level 2 certificate in Health and Safety course is designed to create a better understanding of Health and Safety the emphasis being on making the employer and employee safe for himself, safe for others and capable of identifying potential hazards.

The aim is to reduce the likelihood of accidents occurring in the workplace. 'Health and safety' takes as its starting point the fact that most accidents are attributable to lack of knowledge or carelessness and that the key to improvement is increased awareness on everybody's part.
